Art Project Evaluation for Color and Value Drawings

A (90 – 100):

- You used black, white, and the primary colors to make more than 3 new colors or values.
- You followed all of the directions for taking proper care of the materials.
- All of the things in your painting were drawn and colored neatly.

B (80 – 90):

- Your landscape shows four things that happen outside in winter
- You used black, white, and the primary colors to make 3 new colors or values.
 - You followed almost all of the directions for taking proper care of the materials.

C (70 – 80):

- Your landscape shows three things that happen outside in winter

D (60-70):

- Your landscape shows two or fewer things that happen outside in winter
- You used black, white, and the primary colors to make 1 or fewer new color or value.
 - You did not follow many of the directions for taking proper care of the materials.
 - Many of the things in your painting were not drawn and colored neatly.

F (below 60):

- You did not try to do the project.
